The City of Paterson Historic Preservation Commission warmly invites all community members, friends and supporters of Paterson's heritage to a presentation and tour of historic Eastside & Westside Parks. **Please note that this tour and presentation have been rescheduled for Saturday, October 29th.** This free event will highlight significant and unique features and monuments in each park. The event begins with a free presentation at 11 AM in the White House in Eastside Park. This presentation will introduce the history of Paterson's earliest parks and the earliest movement to plan and develop the city's public spaces. Following the presentation there will be two tours: one of Eastside Park at 12:15 PM and another of Westside Park at 2:00 PM. These walking tours will familiarize visitors with the parks' landscape, monuments and their cultural significance.

Each tour is expected to last one hour. Please dress appropriately for the weather and bring water. We also encourage everyone to bring lunch and picnic in the park following the tour of Eastside Park. Visitors are asked to provide their own transportation to Westside Park for the second tour if they wish to attend (maps and directions will be provided).
