City of Paterson, Passaic Valley Water Commission and Great Falls National Historic Park temporarily close pedestrian bridge that crosses Passaic River in Great Falls National Park

Paterson - - The pedestrian footbridge that crosses the Passaic River has been temporarily closed for repairs.

Currently, the Passaic Valley Water Commission, owners of the foot-bridge, have structural engineering consultants developing a temporary support system that will allow the bridge to reopen within a short period of time.

"We anticipate this to be short-term, and apologize for any inconvenience this may cause," said Mayor Jose 'joey' Torres. "The City of Paterson, Passaic Valley Water Commission and the National Park Service are working towards a long-term solution to provide permanent access for all visitors to the park."

To move from Overlook Park across the river to Mary Ellen Kramer Park, or vice versa, visitors can use the Wayne Avenue bridge.
