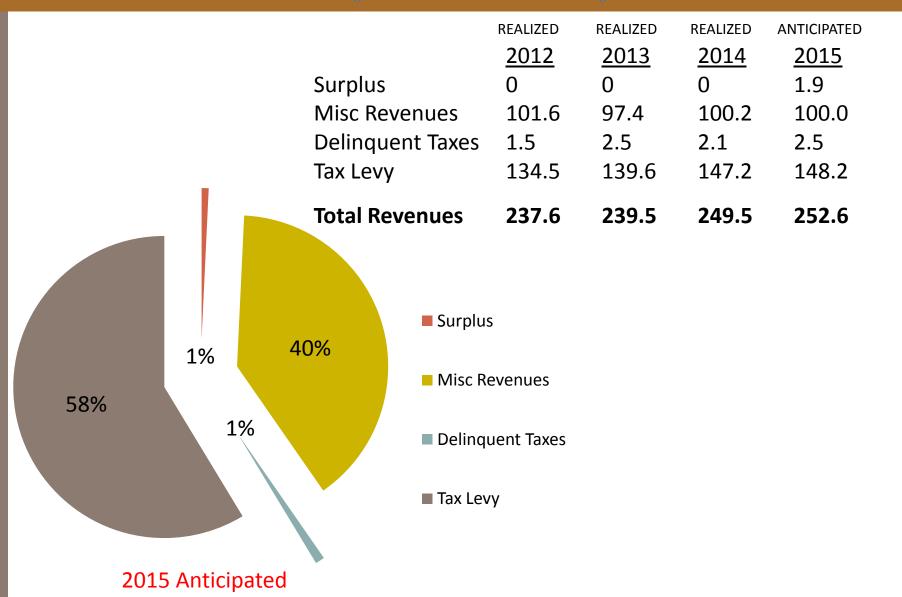

Revenues – Expenses = Tax Levy



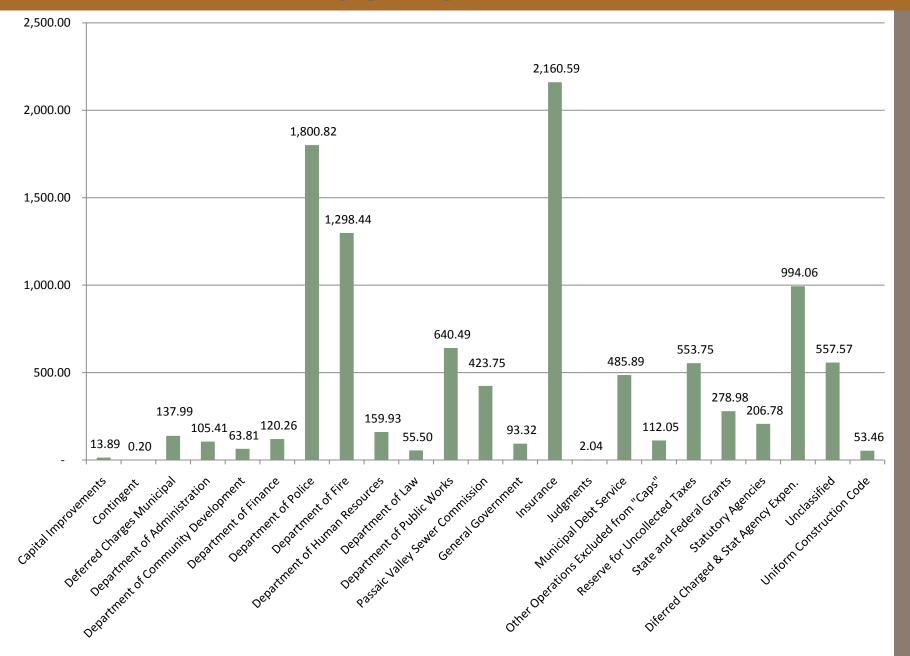
Revenues (\$ in Millions)



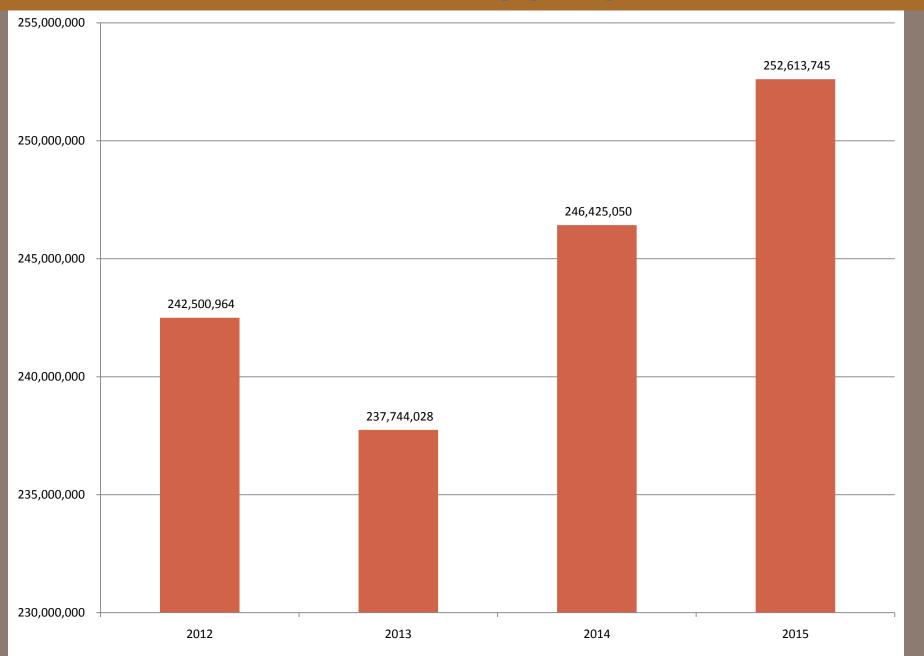

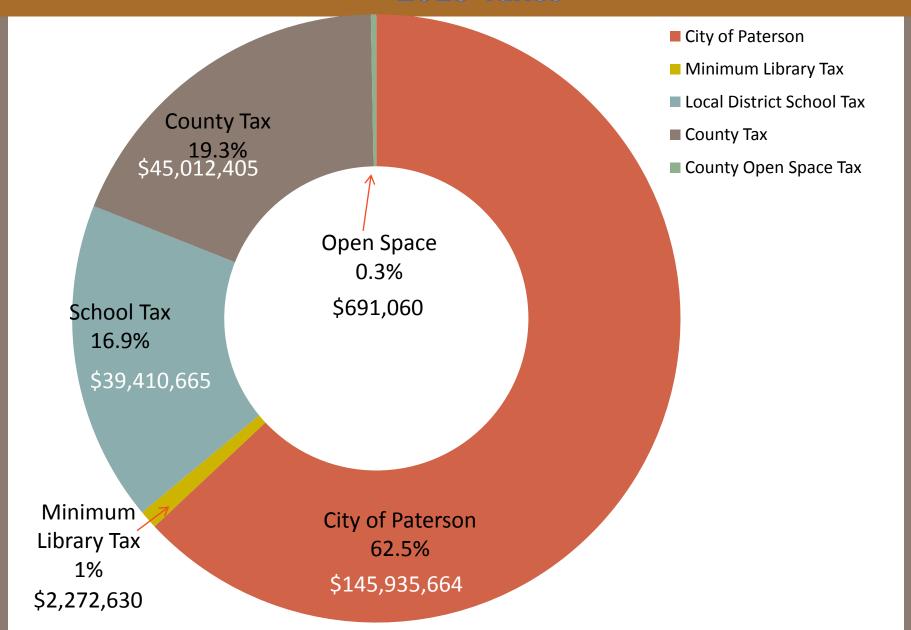

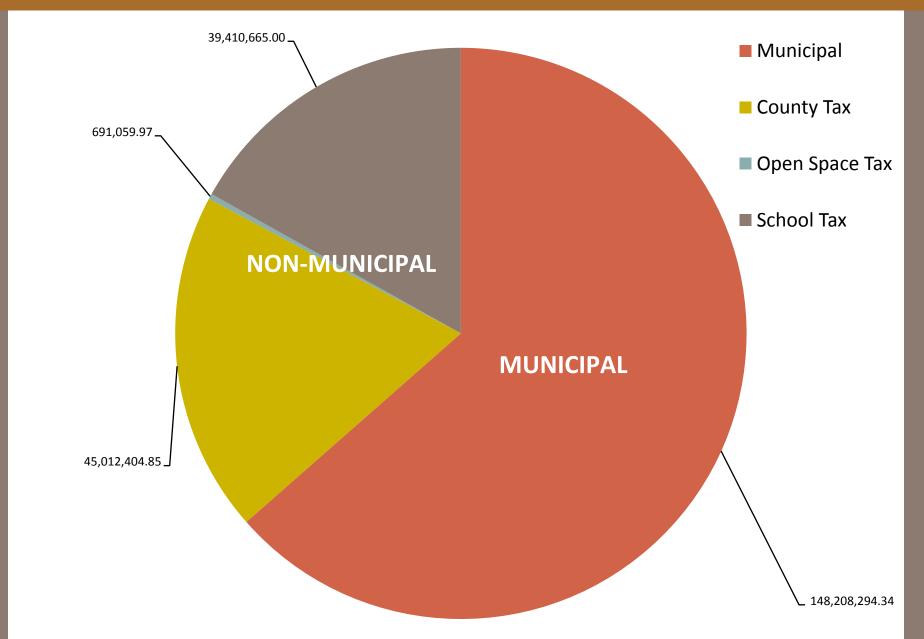


How Your Tax Dollar is Spent

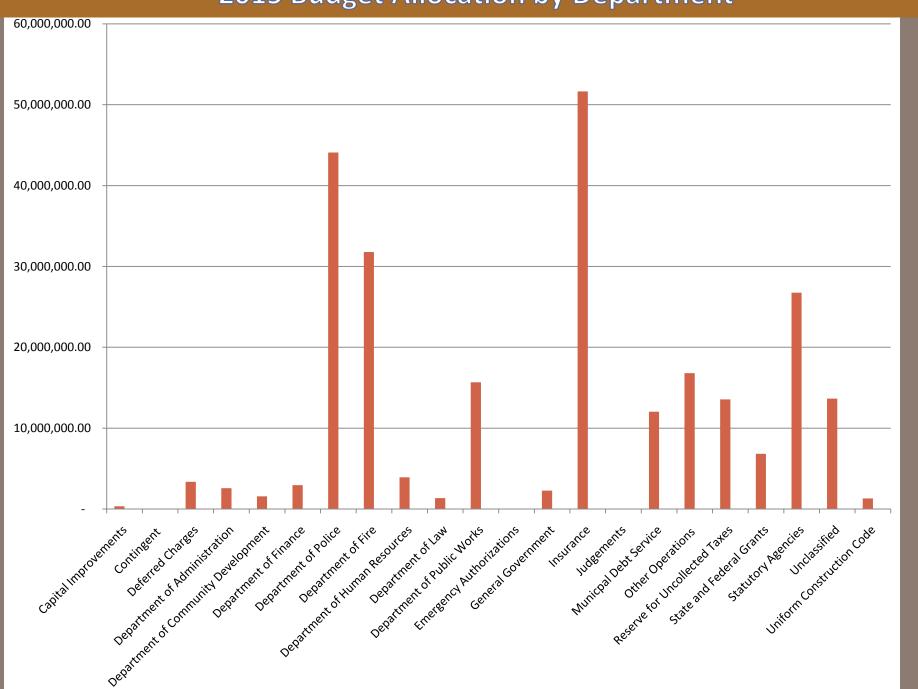

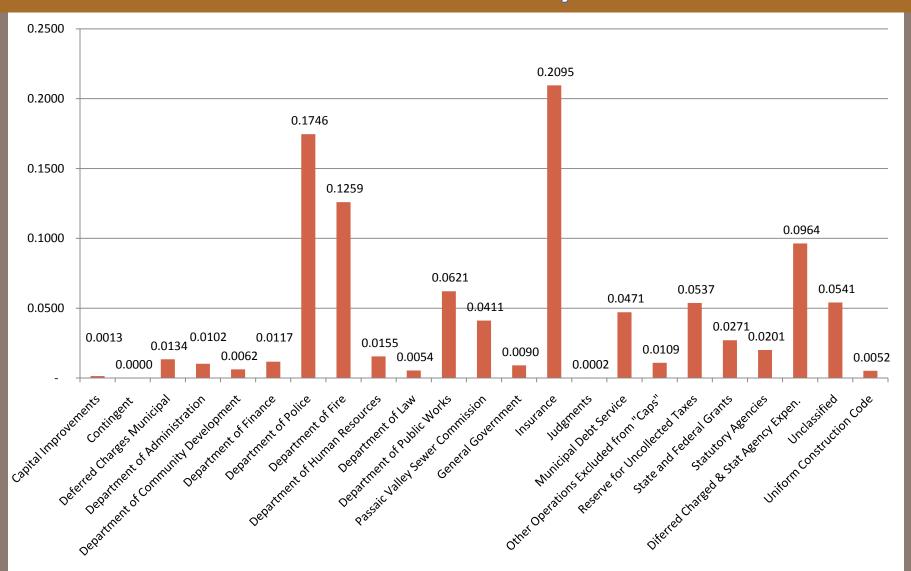

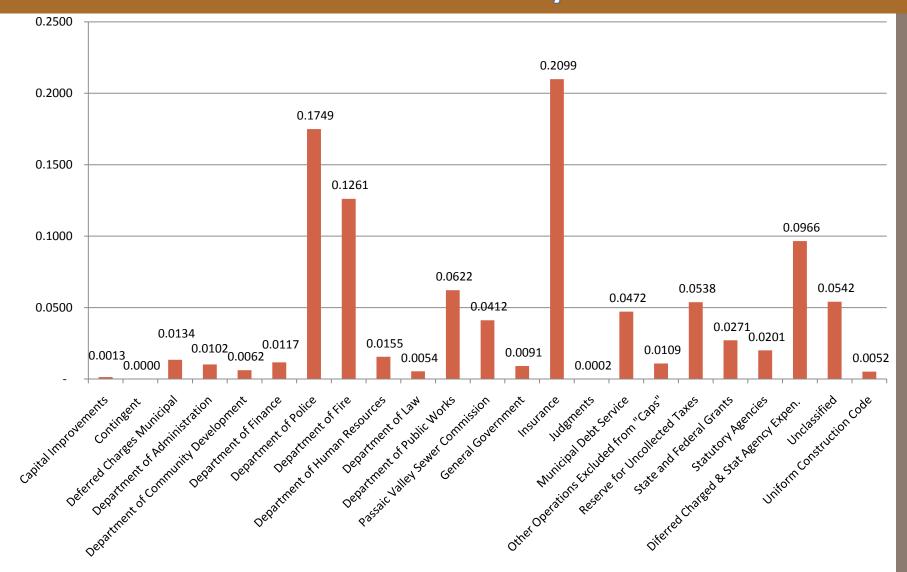

How Much Do You Pay Per Dollar?



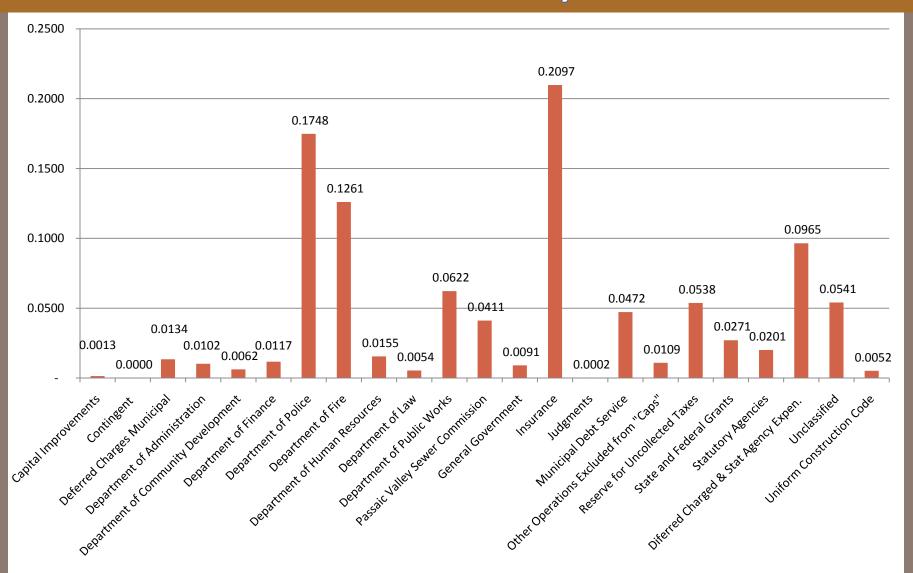
Assessed Value of \$250,000
