

**CITY OF PATERSON:
NOTICE OF EMERGENCY MEETING ON AUGUST 3, 2016
AS AN EXCEPTION TO THE ORDINARY REQUIREMENTS
OF THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT.**

**BE ADVISED THAT THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATERSON
SCHEDULED AN EMERGENCY MEETING FOR WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 3, 2016, AT 8:00
P.M. TO BE HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, THIRD FLOOR, 155 MARKET STREET,
PATERSON, NEW JERSEY.**

The ordinary notice requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act, codified in pertinent part at N.J.S.A. 10:4-8(d) and N.J.S.A. 10:4-9(a), would require this Notice to be published no later than 8:00 PM on Monday, August 1, 2016. However, it was necessary to call this meeting pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-9(b) because of an emergency that developed, to be addressed by the potential adoption of the following Resolution:

FORMAL ACTION WILL BE TAKEN

The said emergency was the need to approve a Resolution to amend the allocation of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) funding. Said CDBG Funding will be allocated to the City’s Department of Public Works, Recreation Division, Summer Program. Such reallocation is necessary so that the City’s municipal pools will remain open through Labor Day. Therefore the City’s youth will be safe and occupied during the day, as schools are not back in session yet.

On Monday, August 1, 2016, the meeting was called, and notice was given by posting at City Hall, 155 Market Street, by filing it with the City Clerk, and by sending the notice by fax or e-mail to the Herald News, the Record, and other newspapers used for Public Notices as required by N.J.S.A. 10:4-9b(3).

Other than a **SHORT PUBLIC PORTION**, as required by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(a), this emergency meeting was to be limited to the discussion of and/or action on the above-described emergent matters. This emergency meeting was to take place on a night without a duly-noticed Workshop, without a duly-noticed Regular Meeting, and without any other Special Meeting.
