### **AGENDA:**

1. New Jersey Community Development Corporation 157 Wayne Avenue; Block 923, Lot 9

The applicant proposes to construct a four (4) unit dwelling on a vacant 2,400 square foot lot. The first floor proposes a two-bedroom unit of 900 square feet and common hall and stairway access of 200 square feet. The second floor also proposes a two-bedroom unit of 900 square feet and common hall and stairway access of 200 square feet. The third floor proposes one studio unit of 397 square feet, 1 one-bedroom unit of 603 square feet and common hall and stairway access of 100 square feet. This proposal is within the R-3 High Medium Density Residential District. Variances are requested for minimum lot square footage area as a four (4) unit dwelling requires 6,600 square feet (1,650 square feet per dwelling unit) and 2,400 square feet exists; a minimum lot width of fifty (50) feet is required and twenty-five (25) feet of lot width exists; a minimum front-yard setback of ten (10) feet is required and a front-yard setback of three (3) feet is proposed; minimum side-yard setbacks of three (3) feet are required on both side-yards and portions of the building are proposed on both side-yard lot lines; and a lot coverage of 40 percent is permitted and lot coverage of 45.8 percent is proposed. A total of eight (8) off-street parking spaces are required and zero (0) off-street parking spaces are proposed.
