NOTICE PURSUANT TO THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT, ADDRESSING EFFECT OF CORONAVIRUS MEASURES ON THE NEXT PUBLIC MEETING:

CONSISTENT WITH THE CORONAVIRUS-RELATED RESTRICTIONS OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 107, GIVEN ON SATURDAY, MARCH 21, 2020 BY GOVERNOR PHILIP D. On Monday, August 31, 2020, there will be a Special Meeting of the Paterson Planning Board which will be held at **6:30 p.m.**, Via Webinar Session. The following matter will be heard:

1. Barclay Street Housing, LLC

85 Chadwick Street & 133-155 Barclay Street; Block 5507, Lots 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18

On the northeast corner intersection of Chadwick Street and Barclay Street, on a 27,247 square foot site that is vacant of structures, the applicant proposes to construct a five-story affordable housing development of 56 residential units on the upper floors and a first floor that includes a Community Room, Offices, an Exercise Room, a Health Services Office, and Meeting Space. Fifteen (15) one-bedroom units, 29 two-bedroom units, and 12 three-bedroom units are proposed. Thirty-nine (39) off-street parking spaces are also proposed. Driveway access for the site is proposed from Chadwick Street. Variances are requested for exceeding the maximum impervious lot coverage, as seventy (70) percent impervious lot coverage is permitted and ninety-two (92) percent impervious lot coverage is proposed. A rear-yard minimum setback of fifteen (15) feet is required and the applicant proposes a minimum rear-yard setback of 0.29 feet. Thirty-nine (39) of the required ninety-two (92) off-street parking spaces are provided,

which requires a parking variance of fifty –three (53) off-street parking spaces. The parcel is located in the MU-H Mixed Use Hospital District of the Area 11 Neighborhood Redevelopment Plan.
