NOTICE OF MEETING WITHOUT 48-HOUR ADVANCE PUBLISHED NOTICE, AS AN EXCEPTION TO THE ORDINARY ADVANCE NOTICE REQUIREMENTS OF THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT.

BE ADVISED THAT THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATERSON HAS SCHEDULED A MEETING FOR WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 29, 2021, AT 6:30 P.M. TO BE HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, THIRD FLOOR, 155 MARKET STREET, PATERSON, NEW JERSEY.
