

**CITY OF PATERSON**  
Distribution of Federal Funds,  
Public Comment Period and Public Meeting  
For Annual Action Plan Year 2022-23

Each year the City of Paterson receives entitlement funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME), Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA), and Homeless Emergency Solutions Grant (HESG) Programs. As part of this process, the City of Paterson, in consultation with various organizations and agencies develops an Annual Action Plan that outlines the resources and activities needed to address the objectives of the Consolidated Plan. The amounts allocated to the City of Paterson from HUD for fiscal year 2022-23, which starts July 1, 2022, and ends June 30, 2023, are as follows:

HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME)	\$1,228,480.00
Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDs (HOPWA)	\$1,891,705.00
Homeless Emergency Solutions Grant (HESG)	<u>\$222,146.00</u>
