AVAILABILITY OF UNUSED CDBG AND HESG FUNDS

Annually, the City of Paterson receives entitlement funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Homeless Emergency Solutions Grant (HESG) Programs. HUD requires that the City submit an Annual Action Plan every year.

The purpose of this public notice is to advise the availability of unused CDBG and HESG funds from the following program years:

HESG	2022	\$55,485.00	for shelter operations

All interested persons are encouraged to complete the 2022 CDBG application for public services and public facility improvements, and the 2022 HESG application for shelter operations, prevention or rapid re-housing services. The applications are available for download at the City's website www.patersonnj.gov/cd. These applications can be picked up at the Department of Community Development, 125 Ellison Street, 2nd Floor, Paterson, NJ 07505. Completed applications (one original and two copies) must be submitted to the Department of Community Development no later than Friday, July 1, 2022 by 12:00 Noon.
