Mayor Jones stood in a local restaurant "Jacksonville". He has \$15 to spend. From the Menu he can see that:


- A. 2 Kebabs, 1 portion of chips and a can of soda = \$7.90

- D. 2 Kebabs, 1 Burger and 3 portions of chips = \$11.25




