***Paterson Historic Preservation Commission
Offers Koar-George Fund Grants for Student Scholarships***

The City of Paterson Historic Preservation Commission is pleased to announce the 2019 Koar-George Grant round which is open to Paterson residents who are enrolled in an accredited college/university with a focus in history, architecture, cultural studies, museum studies, or related field. The 2019 Koar-George Grant application deadline is **April 1, 2019**.

These grants are made possible by the Koar-George Fund, which was the vision of Grace George, former Director of the Visitor Center for the Great Falls Historic District of Paterson. Grace George created the Koar-George Fund as her legacy, a lasting commitment and service to the preservation of Paterson's history.

Grant applications will be accepted for the category of **The Grace George Scholarship (Category F)**: For encouraging "a Paterson resident who is enrolled in an accredited college/university with a focus on history, architecture, museum studies or related field."

Grant amounts for the scholarship are offered as a single award of \$1,000.00 and may, depending on the number of applications, be divided into two awards of \$500.00.
