

**CITY OF PATERSON  
NOTICE OF EMERGENCY MEETING ON JUNE 8, 2021  
AS AN EXCEPTION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF OPEN  
PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT.**

**BE ADVISED THAT THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATERSON HAS SCHEDULED AN EMERGENCY MEETING FOR TUESDAY, JUNE 8, 2021, AT 5:30 P.M. TO BE HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, THIRD FLOOR, 155 MARKET STREET, PATERSON, NEW JERSEY.**

The normal notice requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act have not been met. It is necessary to call this meeting by vote of three-fourths of the Council Members present pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-9 because of an emergency situation that has developed, specifically:

- 2. PUBLIC PORTION**

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-9(b), such meeting is required in order to deal with matters of such urgency and importance that a delay for the purpose of providing adequate notice would be likely to result in substantial harm to the public interest.

This meeting was called on Tuesday, **June 8, 2021** and on that day, notice of this meeting was given by posting the notice at City Hall, 155 Market Street, Paterson, New Jersey, by filing it with the City Clerk, and by sending the notice by fax to the Herald News and the Record, the N.J. Pulse, the Paterson Press and other newspapers used for Public Notices as required by N.J.S.A. 10-4-9(b)(3). This meeting will be limited to the discussion of and/or action on the above-described emergent matters.
