CITY OF PATERSON NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY FROM ANNUAL ACTION PLAN YEAR 2024 & 2025

Annually, the City of Paterson receives entitlement funding from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Homeless Emergency Solutions Grant (HESG) Programs. HUD requires the City to prepare and submit an Annual Action Plan each year outlining the proposed use of these federal funds.

The purpose of this public notice is to inform the public of the need to amend the Year 2024 and 2025 budgets for the CDBG Program. **Approximately \$755,762.95 in CDBG funds are available for eligible shovel-ready public facilities and park improvement projects.**

Interested applicants must possess a valid New Jersey Certificate of Good Standing at the time the application is submitted. All proposed activities will be evaluated and underwritten for program eligibility, feasibility, and compliance with applicable HUD requirements. **All awarded CDBG funds must be fully obligated and expended no later than September 30, 2026.**

All interested non-profit 501(c)(3) agencies are encouraged to complete the 2026 CDBG Parks and Public Facilities Improvements Application available on the City of Paterson website (www.patersonnj.gov), under the Community Development section. Applications are also available at the Department of Community Development, 125 Ellison Street, 2nd Floor, Paterson, New Jersey.

Completed applications must be submitted to the Department of Community Development no later than **Thursday, June 18, 2026, at 12:00 Noon**. Applicants are required to submit one (1) signed original application and three (3) copies.
